



Aster Flower Scarf

Finished size: 8" (20 cm) x 65" (165 cm)

LEVEL: Intermediate

Time to complete: 2-3 hours

MATERIALS

Yarn: 2 Balls Merino No. 5 (74 yards 68 m, 5.3 oz 150 g each), 100% Merino
Knitting Needles: US 36 20 mm 24" 60 cm

PATTERN

Gauge: Flower = 3" (7.5cm) diameter
Flower w/ diameter = 4" (10cm) diameter

Color A – Border
Color B – Flower Color

Abbreviations:

SL = Slip Stitch (this means that you insert your right needle into the next stitch as if to purl, then move it to the right needle)

K = Knit

P = Purl

yo = Yarn Over

Aster Flower Pattern –

With yarn in front - Slip 5 sts to right-hand needle dropping extra loops, slip these 5 sts back to left-hand needle, (P1, yo, P1, yo, P1) work all 5 sts together without removing from needle (you will end with 5 stitches on the right needle).

Cast on 13 sts

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Color A – K13

Row 2 (Right Side): Color B - SL 1, * K5-wrapping yarn twice around needle for each st, SL 1; repeat from * to end

Row 3: Color B, SL 1, * Aster flower, SL 1; repeat from * to end

Row 4: Color A, K1, * K5, knit the next stitch with the loose strand in back; repeat from * to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 5: Color A, K13

Row 6: Color B, SL 4, * K5-wrapping yarn twice around needle for each st, SL 1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, SL 3

Row 7: Color B, SL 4, * Aster flower, SL 1; repeat from * to last 3 sts, SL 3

Row 8: Color A, K4, * K5, knit next stitch with the loose strand behind; repeat from * to last 9 sts, K9

Row 9: Color A, K13

Row 10-113: Repeat rows 2-9

Row 114-116: Repeat rows 2-4

Cast Off

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
